Let us learn these Duas 1. (Surah 2 : Al-Baqarah, Verse: 201)

رَبَّنَا آتِنَا فِي الدُّنْيَا حَسَنَةً وَفِي الْآخِرَةِ
حَسَنَةً وَقِنَا عَذَابَ النَّارِ

*Rabbanaa aatinaa fiddunyaa hasanatan wafil aakhirati
hasanatan waqinaa adhaabannaar.*

Meaning: Our Lord, give us good in this life, and in the Hereafter and protect us from the Hellfire.

2. (Surah 2 : Al-Baqarah, Verse: 286)

رَبَّنَا لَا تُؤَاخِذْنَا إِنْ نَسِينَا أَوْ أَخْطَأْنَا

Rabbanaa laa tu'aakhidhnaa in-naseenaa aw akhta'naa

Meaning: Our Lord! Do not impose blame upon us if we have forgotten or erred.

3. (Surah 28 : Al-Qasas , Verse : 24)

رَبِّ إِنِّي لِمَا أَنْزَلْتَ إِلَيَّ مِنْ خَيْرٍ فَقِيرٌ

Rabbi innee limaa anzalta ilayya min khairin faqeer

Meaning : My Lord! I am truly in need of whatever good that You bestow on me

Q.1. What does Allah ask us to do in return of all His favours?

Ans. Allah asks us to be good and thankful to Him and worship Him alone

Q.2. Who is the Lord of the Day of Judgement and to whom should we turn for help?

Ans. Allah is the Lord of the Day of Judgement and to Him alone we must turn for help.

Q.3. Who is a Muslim ?

Ans. A Muslim is a person who believes that there is no God but Allah and that Prophet Muhammed (Peace be upon him) is the Messenger of Allah.

Q.4. How many daily prayers are there ? Name them.

Ans. There are Five daily prayers. They are –

- a) Salat-ui-Fajr
- b) Salat-uz-Zuhr
- c) Salat-ul-Asr
- d) Salat-ul-Maghrib
- e) Salat-ul-Isha
