Examination scheduled to be held on Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> January 2010.

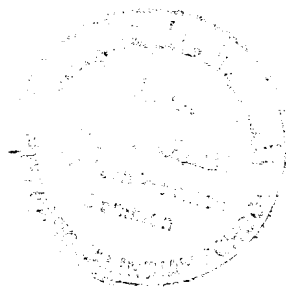
### **AWARDS:**

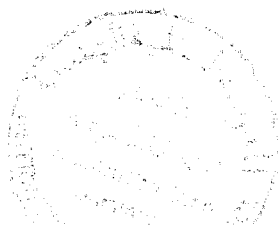

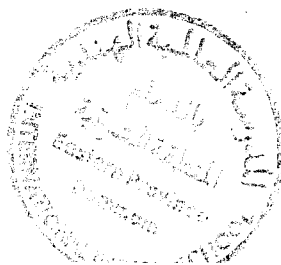

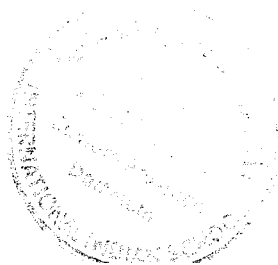
